CURRENT ENCOURAGEMENTS

We are grateful for much that the Lord accomplished in and through His HELPING HANDS ministry last year. Among many other things, we praise Him, and are grateful to His people, for the support that was shown at the benefit concert on December 14th. We are especially thankful for the many Christian artists who freety gave of

their time and talent to help us further expose this ministry to the Greek Christians and helped us raise over 400.000 drachmas!

A large portion of that money was immediately put to use buying food supplies for the Kurdish refugees at the camp in Agios Andreas. On December 22nd, more than six cars and one bus full of people and gifts of food, toiletries, and toys arrived at the camp. After unloading the donations, we sang some Christian carols. acted a pantomime, and had an Arabic evangelist (Karnal) share the meaning of Christmas with many open and interested Muslim Kurds. Unfortunately, due to the farmer's road blockades, the Kurdish literature we had ordered never arrived in time for us to hand out in response to the many requests for Gospels after our presentation. However, God's Spirit was at work and He used us to be a blessing of light to many who are in darkness.

We visited the Kurdish camp again with cars and a busload of people and donations on January 26th, and after a program we were able to hand out about 1,000 Gospels of Luke in their own language. Many were asking for more literature, Bibles, and New Testaments. They are OPEN AND HUNGRY people. What an opportunity to reach an «urreached-people group for Jesus! We have been there four times now, and plan to go again soon.

On December 24th, we had a special Christmas Ewe Soup Kitchen. The Hellenic Missionary Union already had the hall beautifully decorated. With the addition of red tablecloths, special Christmas plates, and cantels at each table, there was a very seasonal atmosphere. Once again, a Greek athletic club donated much food so that we could offer a nice three course meal to over 150 hungry people. In addition to a short drama, the program people. In addition to a short drama, the program

included a message from Kamal for the Arabic-speaking people and a message through speaking and singing from one of Greece's most loved Christian artists: 'Xendon loannids. Because of some very generous donations, we were able to print enough sweatshirts to give out to everyone at the soup kitchen that night. The sweatshirts have a graphic printing on the front (the head of Christ wearing the crown of thoms), and on the back (two nail-scarred hands with the words «HELPING HANDS» in English and Greek. We have received many expressions of appreciation (and additional requests) for these practical grifts that give an impacting «silent withness» each time they are worn.


