## SUMMER REPORT

This summer HELPING HANDS did not go on ... holiday. It was present in Pendeli, in Omonia, in Koumoundourou square, wherever there are foreigners, refugees and persons in need. We have tried to remain faithful to our God-given vocation and to be useful to our fellow humans, working as quietly and methodically as possible. Our aim is to offer ourselves rather than to give alms.

Our gratitude goes to the Lord of the work for the blessings that accompanied us. Our esteem goes to the recipients for their cooperation and response in our common effort for their economic, social, psychological and spiritual rehabilitation.

#### IN PENDELI

We visited on five occasions this mini...Kurdistan of Pendeli, bringing a total of two tons of staples, hundreds of New Testaments and leaflets in Arabic. Along with us came brothers and sisters of various nationalities and races, all

attracted and united by the example of Jesus Christ. Others too assisted through their work, financial contributions and prayers. Useful as all these efforts were, they are not sufficient to solve the problems. Greater efforts are needed, further help, more substantial participation. The reason is there are only two toilets for seven hundred people, insufficient water in tanks (and therefore dangerous to health), and limited electricity. The tents do not have any secure base or covering in case of rain. Furthermore, winter is already upon them with freezing nights and bad weather. The construction of the school and the kitchen is still unfinished and cooking is done in a rudimentary way using pieces of wood which could start a fire in the Pendeli forest.

The children wander hungry and barefooted here and there under their mothers' hopeless stares. Nearby, the men do not hide their concern for colder days.

As humans and as Christians, we need to do a lot more for these precious souls who surely deserve a great part of our love.

#### ABOUT MEALS

Refugees are not only in Pendeli, but also in the heart of Athens, where they do not even have tents to stay in.

Kurds, Iraqis, Iranians, Romanians, Russians and homeless
Greeks were our guests in the weekly «Meal of Love and Hope»,
which this summer was offered in the «Refuge» hall.

Every Tuesday evening about 120 persons received a tasty cold
meal, warm Christian hospitality and artistic program, which
revived their interest in living, and especially a true life.

Our aim for this winter is to continue and increase the number of
meals to two or three a week. The needs are increasing along with
the response, and we see new possibilities which can be created
with God's help...

### REFUGEE CENTER

The third important event which took place for us this summer, was the renting of our own center near Omonia, where the main

part of our activities will be held.

It consists of a small, well-lit space on the fifth floor. This is being prepared to be used as "Refugee Center" with a cafe-restaurant, a place of social contacts and special events, a classroom for the free teaching of Greek and English, a library and an office to receive refugees and assist them with finding jobs and other needs.

We hope the center will soon be ready to provide for the refugees

of central Athens a place of rest and hope. It will also provide an opportunity for all the friends who support our cause to offer participation and service.
