When we tell people about Rockwood (a community within the municipality of Gresham, and 1/3 of the population), we use statistics to ground our story in facts. Here are facts:

The table shows how we calculate a life expectancy of 75.2 years for Rockwood. The rest of the municipality is 79.7 years, so Rockwood is 4.5 years shorter.


For the rest of Multnomah County (the county in which Rockwood is located and the one in which we live), the numbers vary widely, but they are always higher than Rockwood. The range is a full 10 to 15 years.

Compared to the rest of the world, 75.2 is in the "developing world" category.


move on to discover what they ARE gifted in and develop those gifts.
