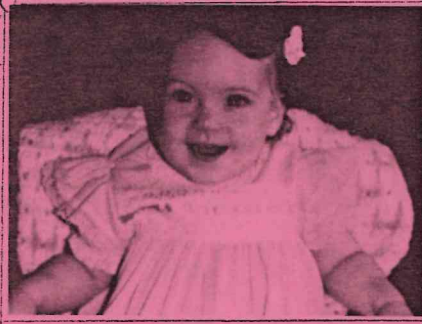

Like, eat by myself and hide things and lock myself out on the balcony and knock to get in. Mommy and Daddy laughed the first few times, but now I get the feeling that it's not so funny by the 10th time in one hour! I like to give them something to do!

My Daddy is very busy. Lately he's been teaching at the Filipino fellowship and the Ethiopian church. He also leads a Bible study at my house on "Worship and Warfare". They learn about it and then they practice! He goes to Greek class and to the prison and to church stuff. He gets to take care of me a lot, too! I like that!

Mommy seems to be in the kitchen a lot! She cooks for me and Daddy and also for lots of company! Not so long ago we had a man and his sister from Iraq come to our house for dinner and talking. (Grown-up stuff.) Daddy and Mommy talked about Jesus to them. Want to read what Nadia wrote in our guestbook? "... and I remember now the hymn of 'Amazing Grace' - I don't know why, maybe because I feel there'll be a change in my



life after this evening, and I'm sure it'll be a good change. So thanks to you both, and I hope our friendship will continue, all through life and maybe in eternal life too!" Please keep praying for David and Nadia.

Mommy is also taking Greek classes. She and Daddy like them, but they say it's getting harder! It takes a lot of time, too. I just keep telling them, "Ελληνικά είναι εύκολα!" (Greek is easy!)

At Christmas time we will go where refugees live and give cookies to them and invite them to see the "Jesus" movie in their own language. Some people from our church will help. We hope to meet some people who want to know about Jesus. Please pray that this will be an effective outreach. (Mommy had to help me spell those big words!)

Please pray for our team in training in Chicago - Jason, Alex, Ron, and Lois. Hopefully, they will join us in January to help work with the refugees! I will have four new friends! 😊 They need some more money to come, so please pray for that.

Well, I'd like to tell you about some of my favorite toys and my new tricks, but Mommy says it's nap time. I love you! Thank you for all your love and prayers. You help Jesus take good care of us!
