Christmas is long past, but we can't help but tell you about it, even now. This Christmas, our primary outreaches took place at three Christmas parties designed for families and children. On two nights running, we invited 500 children and parents to enjoy a cooked meal, live entertainment, and a family photo in front of the Christmas tree. As they left, each received a gift—something small for the parents and an overflowing backpack for every child.

Then, on the Saturday before Christmas, we made the ARC into a **Christmas Toy Village** for children. Each child was given a ticket that entitled them to "buy" toys in heaped toy rooms and grab some yummy hot chocolate and cakes in the "café" run by local school children. They were also able, in other corners of the hall, to have their faces painted, make a nativity scene, decorate cookies and choose nice children's clothes. It was a party and a half!

But we saw in the comments of a few refugees that there was something to these parties beyond giving people a little joy and a few toys.

"S" commented, just before he left the party with his wife and child, "I pray to God that He will help me understand Jesus, because I have seen love in these people here."

Then it was Mr. "G", still a Muslim, with his five children and wife, who said, "We do not come here anymore for the food. We have food on our table

every day now. We come because we are treated as friends."

And last was the comment of a young Afghani man, who spoke (positively) of the ARC as "that place of Jesus."

NEW LIFE

(THE FOLLOWING WAS RECENTLY WRITTEN BY OUR IRANIAN TEAMMATE NADER)...

IT WAS TUESDAY MORNING AT THE ATHENS REFUGEE CENTER WHEN "A", A KURDISH MAN, SHOWED UP LOOKING FOR SOMEONE WHO COULD SPEAK WITH HIM IN FARSI. HE SAID HE HAD BEEN A MEMBER OF A POLITICAL PARTY IN KURDISTAN FOR 4 YEARS (WHERE THEY TAUGHT THEM TO FIGHT WITH GUNS FOR FREEDOM).

"I HAD NO INTEREST FOR RELIGION AND GOD BUT MY INTEREST WAS FOR A NEW GUN AND NEW TACTICS FOR FIGHTING," HE SAID.

IT TOOK 15 DAYS FOR HIM TO COME TO ATHENS THROUGH THE SMUGGLERS WHO HE PAID 4,000 EUROS. HE STAYED WITH OTHER KURDISH PEOPLE IN ATHENS. ONE NIGHT HE SAW A DREAM. IN HIS DREAM SOMEBODY WAS CALLING HIM. HE LOOKED UP AND SAW WRITING IN THE SKY HE COULDN'T READ. HE HEARD AGAIN THE VOICE CALLING HIM. SAYING. "COME TO ME". HE WOKE UP CRYING AND SHAKING. HE TOLD THE OTHER KURDISH GUYS ABOUT HIS DREAM. HOPING THEY COULD HELP HIM UNDERSTAND. THEY TOLD HIM TO GO TO THE RELIGIOUS PEOPLE AND ASK THEM ABOUT HIS DREAM, AND THEY DIRECTED HIM TO OUR MINISTRY CENTER.

HE CAME AND TOLD ABOUT HIS DREAM. I WAS LISTENING TO HIS ENTIRE STORY AND I SAID, "I DON'T KNOW WHAT IT MEANS, BUT I KNEW GOD IS CALLING YOU TO COME TO HIM." I TALKED ABOUT GOD AND TOLD HIM THAT FOR MANY YEARS HE FOUGHT FOR FREEDOM AND PEACE THAT HE NEVER RECEIVED; TODAY MAYBE IS THE TIME FOR YOU TO RECEIVE IT THROUGH JESUS...NOT BY GUNS, BUT BY FAITH IN HIM. I TOLD HIM SEVERAL VERSES IN THE BIBLE AND HE LISTENED ATTENTIVELY. HE TOOK MY HAND AND STARTED TO CRY. HE DIDN'T CARE ABOUT ALL THE HUNDREDS OF PEOPLE AROUND US (EVEN THOUGH, FOR HIS SAKE, I TRIED TO STOP HIM). I GAVE HIM A BIBLE TO READ ALONE FOR HIMSELF AND COME BACK TO ASK ANY QUESTIONS HE HAD. READY TO LEAVE HIM ALONE, HE TOOK MY HAND AGAIN AND HE SAID, "IF I READ THE BIBLE AND WANT TO RECEIVE HIM, WHAT SHALL I DO?"

I SAID, "JUST OPEN YOUR HEART AND LET HIM COME INTO YOUR LIFE."

HE SAID, "CAN WE DO THAT NOW?"
SO WE PRAYED AND HE INVITED
CHRIST INTO HIS LIFF!

I WAS SO HAPPY AND GRATEFUL TO GOD TO BRING HIM TO HIMSELF. I WAS HAPPY TO SEE WHAT GOD IS DOING IN THE HEART OF THE PEOPLE. THEN WE PRAYED TOGETHER.
