

"Sacrifices, a forgotten art of modern Christianity"

The people of God of the Old Testament were required to offer many different sacrifices. With the death and resurrection of Christ these sacrifices stopped. Living as children of God, it is not any longer expected from us to offer animals, birds, incense, etc. Does this mean that we are totally free of every sacrifice to the Lord?

NO! WE ARE NOT FREE!

God expects us to worship Him daily and to offer our bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to Him (Rom.12:1-2). More specifically God is pleased when we offer to Him:

I. The sacrifice of praise...

"Through Jesus, therefore. Let us continually offer a sacrifice of praise..."

(Heb. 13:15)

With our lips, voice and from our hearts we must offer to God our sacrifice of praise.

II. The sacrifice of witnessing...

"Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God...
the fruit of lips that confess his name..."

It is not enough to offer to God only some hymns of praise. We must use our lips and voice to testify, to confess, to witness to others about our Lord and savior Jesus Christ

III. The sacrifice of doing good and giving

"...and do not forget to do good and to share with others, for with such sacrifices God is pleased."



An Afghan in Constantinople...

Many times we have been asked by believers questions like: "What is happening to the refugees who accept Jesus and then leave Greece?" "Are they sincere?" "How do you know that they are truly saved?" An answer to these questions is what our Team Leader **Scott McCracken** reports:

"H" is one of the many Afghans who have come to Christ through this ministry. While here, he struggled in his new faith. However, he went on from here to Belgium where he became an active part of a church in Brussels, growing

strongly in his faith. Then, after he received his documents from the government of Belgium, he went to TURKEY with the purpose of trying to establish an AFGHAN CHURCH. His first meetings were in October in his small apartment but it is always full, and already more than a dozen Afghans have come to believe in Jesus through his ministry there! He is in regular contact with mature Persian believers in the U.S. and in Athens, humbly requesting and receiving their "long-distance" investments of discipleship in his life!

Please pray for this brother, as he is an extension of our ministry, reaching the nations through Athens!

UPDATE ON DIFFERENT MINISTRIES



The year of 2005 was difficult from some aspects. Even though we faced some challenges, we have seen at the same time God working in our lives and in the lives of those we serve. By God's grace and the support of many believers from Greece and abroad we were able through various services to show Jesus' love to many refugees.

TEA HOUSE

As you probably know by now, three times a week (Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays) we

provide food to approximately 500 refugees each day. Here is how **Scott McCracken** describes one of his Tea House Days:

Today was a "good" day at Tea House. By "good" I mean that there were more people I personally helped than I personally turned away. I was able to share the Gospel with two Afghan men, play ping-

pong with a Somalian, pray for a Nigerian brother who needs work and a place to sleep, play chess with a Libyan refugee, give away several sleeping bags to men and women, and I gave out 25 tickets for men who will come back tomorrow morning to take showers. Between these opportunities and the clothing we gave away, the videos that were watched, the literature that was taken, the food that was eaten, the conversations that were enjoyed, and the classes that were attended, I thank God for a "good day" of sharing His love with the nations.







CLOTHING MINISTRY

Our teammates Ilir and Kate Cami report:

"We thank God for the many clothing donations we receive from churches, schools and individuals throughout Greece, Europe and North America. We give them out as quickly as we get them, and still we don't have enough storage space! And what a blessing it is for refugees to have warm and clean clothes to wear. I particularly enjoy giving clothing to

parents with growing children. One day, a young girl spilled all over herself. She couldn't go out in the cold with wet clothes. I was able to enter our neatly organized clothing room and find an outfit just her size. I wish you could have seen her smile of grateful relief."


