Miss Kendra and Mr. Cody McCracken (Kyle's older sister and brother) informed us that Baby Brother made his escape in broad daylight.

Vital Statistics

Kyle Jordan McCracken escaped from the McCracken Penitentiary on January 14, 1994 at 12:21 p.m. from solitary confinement.

He had been in solitary confinement for the last 9 months. We asked the warden "Mrs. Vicki McCracken" what might have provoked Kyle to make the escape. Warden McCracken said: "There was severe overcrowding in the penitentiary, and it was clear near the last few days before the escape that neither I, nor inmate Kyle, could continue to live this way much longer."

If you should happen to see escaped inmate Kyle, don't try to apprehend him by yourself, as he has been known to be heavily armed with messy diapers. But, immediately contact Police Sergeant Mr. Scott McCracken at the address below. When we asked Sergeant McCracken how he felt about tracking down this heavily armed escaped inmate he said: "It's a dirty job, but someone's got to do it, and unfortunately that's me."
