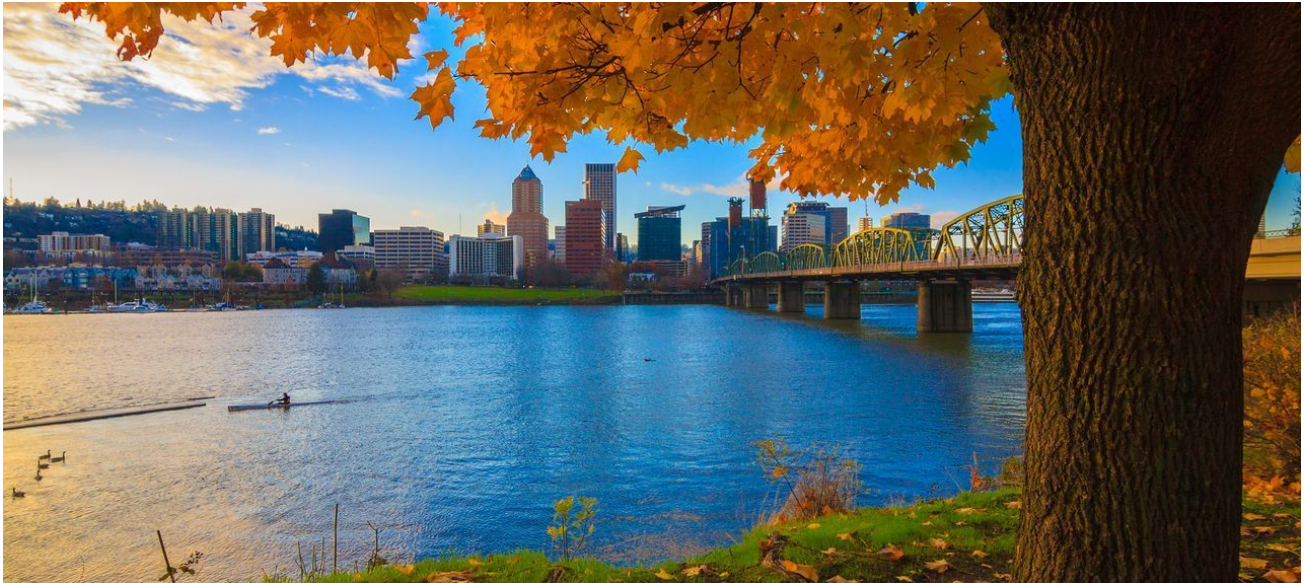

We envision Rockwood becoming a community where children are less vulnerable to being trafficked and adults do not want to traffick kids.

Because our last update was entirely about the short-term mission trip, we wanted to send a "Part 2" to let you know about a couple other important things that happened in September.



In September I (Vicki) had the privilege of speaking at our church's first Women's Conference. We had about 75 ladies attending, and four of us spoke. The conference was entitled "He Calls Me His". I focused on the importance of finding our first and highest calling in being a Child of God, knowing that everything else we are called to flows out of our identity being rooted in Christ. I believe that God spoke to me and through me, and I'm grateful for the opportunity to speak into the lives of so many women that I love!







We held our annual block party at our house on Sept. 8th. Although the weather forecast predicted 90% rain during our designated time (4:00 PM to 7:00 PM), it stopped raining at 4:15 and never started up again. However, it was a smaller group than usual but there was good conversation and peaceful, laid-back fun. We are thankful for how this annual event has been a catalyst for forging new relationships and investing in ongoing ones. Our prayer is that people would come to know the love of Jesus (immediately or eventually) through these bridge-building efforts.
