Cheri: That was such a powerful time Saturday! I'm so excited for what went on; we prayed over so many people I lost count and we had a lot of tears. Many of the people we prayed for would just break down into tears while we were praying and just really share their deep hurts and moods--it was precious! One of the women that that we gave a tamale and one of our flyers to we also were able to give her a heavy coat (because she had no coat and she was freezing). She's from the women's shelter and she had on little sandals with no socks. Her feet were so pink and frozen, and I told her, "If you come to our church tomorrow we can feed you breakfast and get some warm socks and shoes and anything else you need." When she came to church this morning she met Pastor Dave and told him her story and he had her come up front and share with us how she got there; but also someone had given her a word a few days ago that she would be dancing before the Lord when she came today. She found new socks and shoes and said (as she put it), "Now I can dance in my new shoes". What a blessing!
