chess. I sat next to them and, through a translator, I was able to speak to them about Jesus and answer their many questions. I was amazed at their hunger to know about Christ and Christianity. One of the men asked me, "If I become a Christian, what do I gain?" So I told him about eternal life and the peace, joy, love and hope we find in Christ.



PRAYER REQUESTS

- * Continue to pray that God will provide a large facility to house homeless refugees (The Refuge). So far, about \$6000 has been given in response to our team's recent appeal. At least another \$294,000 is needed.
- * Pray for God to send laborers (especially men) to help us in the harvest (there are some possibilities of answers to this prayer that we MAY be able to share with you in the next letter!)
- * Pray for **SPIRITUAL BREAKTHROUGH** among the many
 Afghan refugees
