We have been back in Greece for 5 weeks now! In that time we have: spent three weeks in the hospital with our daughter Kendra, worked in the soup kitchen and seen souls come to Christ, had our bi-annual team retreat, been on television, and witnessed the love, provision, and works of God in a variety of ways! WELCOME BACK TO GREECE!

Before we even made it to the parking lot of the Athens airport (after 21 hours of travel), Kendra was hit by a car. We thank God that a potentially much worse situation only resulted in a broken thigh bone. This required three weeks of traction in the hospital. Because the hospitals here are a little "different", it was necessary for someone to be with Kendra 24 hours a day. Mom took the day shift and Dad took the night shift. God has been gracious in sparing Kendra's life, and has demonstrated much love to us through the many who have prayed, called, visited, helped watch the boys, given gifts, and many other practical ways of helping and loving us.

FEEDING THE HUNGRY

Scott has had the opportunity to help out and speak three times at the soup kitchen that we have on Thursdays. We have been serving between 100 and 200 refugees (and some homeless Greeks) every week. These people are not only hungry for physical food but also for spiritual food, so we always try to share the Gospel with them through preaching, singing, and/or literature. Many have indicated a first-time decision to trust in Yesus! Although this aspect of the ministry will probably stop for the summer, we are planning to start it again in September. PLEASE PRAY THAT MORE CHURCHES AND INDIVIDUALS WILL GET INVOLVED IN HELPING WITH THIS MINISTRY FOR THE FALL.

TELEVISION STAR

Last week Scott had the opportunity to be on an hour long Christian television program that was aired on the TBN station here (the only Christian TV channel in Greece). He had the opportunity to share much about refugee ministry from a theological and "practical" viewpoint, and how people can get involved in our HELPING HANDS ministry here. Currently, we have on our team another family (the Heckenbergs), a single woman (Jennifer), and a part-time couple (the Shifleys). Last weekend we had our bi-annual team vision retreat. We worked primarily on getting to know each other better and on developing a "team covenant". We also worked some on renewing our MasterPlan and setting goals, and praying and worshipping together. Vicki and I are very enthused about the group of people that God has brought together to minister

on our team, and we are sensing that He is deepening our unity to more effectively use us in ministry to the refugees. PLEASE CONTINUE TO PRAY FOR OUR UNITY, AND FOR GOD TO PROVIDE MORE LABORERS FOR THE HARVEST HERE.
