Also the situation that had developed in church with two people has been solved in a Godly way. One of the guys (after a talk we leaders had with them and after a second talk I had with one of them - this all had to take place in our home since I was not so strong to get out) has confessed his sin and guilt in a very humble and godly way, with tears in his eyes. So we have another victory.

Also God has met our financial "low point" in an encouraging way.

Hope this encourages you to see how God has used and answered your prayers for us!

When all the problems where occurring and I was in the hospital bed feeling miserable and receiving all these phone calls I could hear Satan say: "All your sacrifices are in vain. They are amounting to nothing" I was praying next morning and in my heart I heard God softly saying: No, this is no defeat. These are birth pangs!

Next Sunday we have an evangelism Christmas evening, expecting many first time people to join.

On the 24th we have a bigger event at the City Cinema together with the other church plants in Gjilan.

In both events I have to share God's good news of Jesus Christ. Please pray for strength, clarity and guidance from above as I prepare. Secondly pray for lasting fruit coming out of this Christmas season! I have great expectations that all the attacks we faced are related to
