They enjoy school and are doing well. A Greek tutor meets with them once a week to help them in the long journey toward fluency!
- Our new rented facility opened as planned on October 18th! The Lord miraculously provided the necessary money to complete the renovations and met every other need in order to begin ministry there! Weekly soup kitchen, English/Greek classes, and "Tea Bar" three nights a week have now begun. As we feed these needy people, develop friendships, show various evangelistic videos and have Bible discussions, we are seeing physically and spiritually hungry people fed in the name of Jesus!

JOY TO THE WORLD!

As Christmas time approaches, we seek the Lord in knowing how best to reach out to the many lonely and poor that surround us. This year we will be distributing decorated shoeboxes filled with practical and fun items for men, women and children. Thanks to the many of you who have contributed to this effort! We will be handing them out at the soup kitchen, where we plan to have a special meal and a Christmas program. It is such a simple way to demonstrate the love of Jesus, and so meaningful to many who will have no other holiday celebration. Please pray that the Lord's presence will draw many to Himself!

We plan to go up to the Kurdish refugee camp and give a Christmas program and some gifts. There are currently about 1,400 there, living in drafty and wet tents, uncertain about their future. Pray with us that these who feel so "forgotten" will understand that they are truly precious to the Savior!

On December 13th, there will be a concert for the benefit of *Helping Hands*! Many Greek Christian artists will be donating their talents to help further ministry to the refugees and ethnic minorities of Athens. Our desire is not only to raise money, but also to raise awareness among Greek Christians of the many needs around them. We are

On Sunday night, at the Greek evangelical church we attend, many asked thoughtful questions of our Kurdish brother, Halmat, after he shared his personal testimony!

Our desire is to provide a place to sleep for some of the many homeless refugees in Athens. Some of our dear Christian brothers who are themselves refugees, would help us in the running of the facility. As we offer a warm, dry place for "the least of these", we know that we are "doing it as unto the Lord", and we pray that in the process their hearts will be filled with His love and hope! Please pray that the details would all come together- for HIS glory!

Please pray for our dear brother, **Halmat**, as He seeks to lead fellow Kurds out of the dark of Islam and into the light of Jesus! God is using him mightily, but he is paying the price of persecution from fellow countrymen. So MANY are open and hungry, yet so many are afraid to question life-long tradition! Pray for Halmat's protection and encouragement.

Why do we ask for your prayers? Because we know you care about souls, because we know that God uses your prayers to bring glory to Himself here in Athens! We so love you and appreciate your participation in the ministry here. "Ask of me, and I will give the nations as an inheritance for you!" What a wonderful promise!
